ORDINANCE NO. 1977-M - 1

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE SALARY OF ALDERMEN

WHEREAS, it is desired to increase the salaries of aldermen commencing on May 2, 1977; and,

WHEREAS, each alderman devotes a considerable number of hours each week to committee meetings for which no compensation is paid; and,

WHEREAS, Chapter 24, Section 3-13-1 of the Illinois Revised Statutes, 1971, provides that compensation of aldermen may not be increased during a term of office.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ST. CHARLES, KANE COUNTY, ILLINOIS:

Section 1: That on or after May 2, 1977, each alderman taking office shall be paid a salary of \$50.00 for each regular, special or adjourned council meeting as required by law, but that the present aldermen of this council shall serve out their remaining terms, after such date, at the present salary of \$35.00 for each regular, special or adjourned council meeting.

Section 2: All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed insofar as conflicting portions therein are concerned.

Section 3: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval as required by law.
