


ORDINANCE NO. 1972-Z-56



AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE ZONING ORDINANCE AT
SECTION VIII (BUSINESS DISTRICTS)

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City of St. Charles, Kane County, Illinois that the zoning ordinance adopted May 23, 1960 and known as Ordinance No. 1960-16 be further amended in order to delete portions of Section VIII, Business Districts, dealing with laundry and dry cleaning establishments; and

WHEREAS, the Plan Commission and Zoning Board of Appeals have recommended that said amendments be adopted;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ST. CHARLES, KANE COUNTY, ILLINOIS that the zoning ordinance adopted May 23, 1960 and known as Ordinance No. 1960-16 and all the amendments thereto are further amended at Section VIII entitled "Business Districts", as follows:

1) By deleting the words "...provided that laundry machines shall not exceed ten pounds capacity each" from Section VIII. (Business Districts) C. (B-2 Community Business District), 2. (Permitted Uses), dd. (Laundries), and,

2) By deleting the words "...and equipment for dry-cleaning not to exceed one unit of 30 pounds capacity" from Section VIII. (Business Districts), E. (B-3 Business District), 2. (Permitted Uses), m. (Dry cleaning establishments).

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, signing, and publication pursuant to law.


