BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ST. CHARLES, KANE AND DU PAGE COUNTIES, ILLINOIS, as follows:

1. That Title 2, Chapter 2.04, entitled "City Council" Section 2.04.090, entitled "Standing Committees - Designated," of the St. Charles Municipal Code be and is hereby deleted and the following substituted therefor:

"2.04.090 Standing Committees - Designated

The following shall be the standing committees of the City Council:

- A. Finance. The finance committee, in addition to the chairman thereof, shall be comprised of the chairman of the following committees: public safety, health and welfare committee, public works committee, judiciary committee, planning and development committee, and the business, industry and governmental relations committee. The finance committee shall include and pertain to revenue, spending, budget control, labor relations and advisory on personnel administration and policy, procedure manual, and purchasing and inventory control.
- B. Public Safety, Health and Welfare. The public safety, health and welfare committee shall include and pertain to fire, police, civil defense, traffic, parking and public transportation programs, housing, youth commission, human relations program, Tri-Com and requests for community solicitations.
- C. Public Works. The public works committee shall include and pertain to streets, curbs, drainage, sidewalks, parks, buildings, grounds, dutch elm disease, sewerage treatment, sanitary sewers, water, lights, electric distribution and environmental matters.


- D. Judiciary Committee. The judiciary committee shall include and pertain to licenses, review of legal procedures and questions and the municipal code book.
- E. Planning and Development Committee. The planning and development committee shall include and pertain to zoning ordinances, planning and planned unit development matters.
- F. Business, Industry and Governmental Relations Committee. The business, industry and governmental relations committee shall include and pertain to liason with local commercial groups and associations, school and park districts, Kane County Board and St. Charles Township, and development and strengthening of community financial base, including sales tax and real estate taxes.

2. That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval in accordance with law.


