



ORDINANCE NO. 1980-M-36

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 8.08
"AIRCRAFT LANDINGS"



BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ST. CHARLES,
KANE AND DU PAGE COUNTIES, ILLINOIS, as follows:

1. That Chapter 8.08 "Aircraft Landings", Section 8.08.030 "Exemption", of the St. Charles Municipal Code, be and is hereby amended by deleting "Exemption" and substituting the word "Exemptions", by adding before the paragraph thereof "A" and adding the following thereto:

"B. This chapter shall not apply to aircraft used in building construction and movie making provided the user of such aircraft shall have first:

1. Notified the City in writing of the intended use including date, location and amount of time necessary.

2. Provided a certificate of insurance showing liability insurance for property damage and personal injury in an amount and form satisfactory to the City Council.


3. Provided an indemnification agreement in a form with a surety both acceptable to the City Council."

2. That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in accordance with law.




