BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ST.
CHARLES, KANE AND DU PAGE COUNTIES, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

1. That Chapter 17.04, "Rules and Definitions" of
the St. Charles Municipal Code be and is hereby amended by
adding the following thereto:

"17.04.513 Amusement Game Device Arcade

Any establishment, room or place where
more than four (4) amusement game devices
as defined in Chapter 5.14 of the St. Charles
Municipal Code are available to the public."

2. That Chapter 17.24, "B-2 Community Business District",
Section 17.24.030, "Special Uses", of the St. Charles
Municipal Code be and is hereby amended by adding the follow-
ing thereto:

"R. Amusement game device arcade provided:

1. The arcade is properly licensed in
accordance with Chapter 5.14 of the
St. Charles Municipal Code.
2. The portal of any arcade shall not
be located within five hundred feet
(500') of the portal of any elementary,
junior or senior high school, day care
center or church.
3. The arcade shall be located in a
separate room or building, separated
from other uses on the premises and
from pedestrian circulation to and
from such other uses.

4. Amusement game devices shall be located no closer than twelve inches (12") from any wall assembly separating the arcade from any adjacent building or portion of a building. Where devices are located on both sides of any aisle, the aisle shall be not less than ninety inches (90") in width and shall be unobstructed, and such open areas shall be unobstructed. The maximum number of devices in any arcade shall not exceed one (1) device for every forty square feet (40 s.f.) of gross floor allotted to the arcade operation's game area.
5. No amusement game device arcade shall be open for business except between the hours of 10:00 a.m. and 10:00 p.m. on Monday through Thursday and between the hours of 12:00 noon and 10:00 p.m. on Sundays and between the hours of 10:00 a.m. and 11:00 p.m. on Fridays and Saturdays.
6. The application for special use shall be accompanied by a site plan and a floor plan of the premises indicating compliance with all of the above conditions. The site plan shall be a condition of the special use."

3. That Chapter 17.38, "Off-Street Loading and Parking", Sections 17.38.190, "Off-Street Parking - Required Spaces", of the St. Charles Municipal Code be and is hereby amended by adding the following thereto:

"BB. Amusement game device arcades, at least one (1) space per two (2) amusement game devices in addition to the spaces required for any other uses on the premises."


4. That after the adoption and approval hereof the Ordinance shall (i) be printed or published in book or pamphlet form, published by the authority of the Council,


or (ii) within thirty (30) days after the adoption and approval hereof, be published in a newspaper published in and with a general circulation within the City of St. Charles.
