AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 2.04, "CITY COUNCIL"
OF THE ST. CHARLES MUNICIPAL CODE, SECTION
2.04.090, "STANDING COMMITTEES - DESIGNATED"

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ST.
CHARLES, KANE AND DU PAGE COUNTIES, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

1. That Chapter 2.04, "City Council", Section
2.04.090, "Standing Committees - Designated", of the St.
Charles Municipal Code, be and are hereby amended by
deleting the same and substituting the following therefor:

"2.04.090 Standing committees - Designated.

The following shall be the standing
committees of the city council:

- A. **Finance.** The finance committee, in
addition to the chairman thereof, shall be
comprised of the chairman of the following
committees: public safety, health and
welfare committee, public works committee,
judiciary committee, planning and
development committee, and the recycling
committee. The finance committee shall
include and pertain to all financial
matters, budgets, industrial revenue
bonds, bonding, insurance matters
inventory control, purchasing, and
economic development programs.
- B. **Public Safety, Health and Welfare.** The
public safety, health and welfare
committee shall include and pertain to
police, fire and emergency services and
disaster agency, traffic studies, youth
safety, request for community festivals,
mosquito abatement, and permits for
fairs/carnivals/circuses, hot air
balloon/seaplane landing permits.

- C. **Public Works.** The public works committee shall include and pertain to all municipal utilities, all municipal property and buildings; all infrastructure within city jurisdiction (inclusive of curbs and gutters, streets, sidewalks, sewer, water lines, parking lots, etc.), all stormwater management (Special Service Areas or otherwise), and all public property sales.
- D. **Judiciary Committee.** The judiciary committee shall include and pertain to municipal code book, all legal suits or questions, liquor licenses, personnel manual, labor negotiations, and safety manual/programs for employees.
- E. **Planning and Development Committee.** The planning and development committee shall include and pertain to planning and development matters, zoning/annexation/boundary lines, building code enforcement, zoning map, comprehensive plan and land cash ordinance.
- F. **Recycling Committee.** The recycling committee shall include and pertain to communitywide recycling, and all scavenger services/recycling/vendors/marketing of recycled material.
- G. **Special Service Area Advisory Committee.** The special service area advisory committee shall make recommendations to the City Council regarding the expenditures of money within the Special Service Area including expenditures for parking and such other functions as may be assigned by ordinance."

2. That after the adoption and approval hereof the Ordinance shall (i) be printed or published in book or pamphlet form, published by the authority of the Council, or (ii) within thirty (30) days after the adoption and approval hereof, be published in a newspaper published in and with a general circulation within the City of St. Charles.
