

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 10, "VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC", OF THE ST. CHARLES MUNICIPAL CODE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ST. CHARLES, KANE AND DU PAGE COUNTIES, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

1. That Title 10, "Vehicles and Traffic", Chapter 10.11, "Rules of the Road", Section 10.11.2100, "Intersections where stop or yield required", Subsection "A", of the St. Charles Municipal Code, be and is hereby amended by deleting Sub-subsection 3 and 39 and substituting the following therefor:

- "3. On North Third Avenue so that traffic proceeding southbound shall stop at the intersection with Delnor Avenue;
- 39. On Delnor Avenue intersecting North Third Avenue so that eastbound traffic on Delnor Avenue must stop;"

2. That Title 10, "Vehicles and Traffic", Chapter 10.40, "Stopping, Standing and Parking", Section 10.40.040, "No-Parking Places Designated--Prohibited Parking", Subsection "R", of the St. Charles Municipal Code, be and is hereby amended by deleting Exhibit A-8 and substituting the attached therefor and by deleting Exhibit E, Paragraph "9", and substituting the following therefor:

- "9. No parking on the easterly side of Third Avenue from a point 560 feet southerly of the Delnor Avenue right-of-way to a point 200 feet northerly of the Delnor Avenue right-of-way and on the easterly, southerly, westerly and northerly sides of North Third Avenue from a point 560 feet southerly of the Delnor Avenue right-of-way through the merging with Delnor Avenue to Fifth Avenue except for the 110 feet west of Fifth Avenue on the southerly side of Delnor Avenue."

3. That Title 10, "Vehicles and Traffic", be and is hereby amended by adding Chapter 10.44, "Bicycle Paths" as follows:

"10.44 Bicycle Paths

That the westerly 10 feet of North Third Avenue from its intersection with Delnor Avenue northwesterly to Johnor Avenue is hereby designated as a bicycle path."

4. The Director of Public Works or any other person authorized by the Mayor and City Council shall cause stop signs, no parking signs and bicycle path signs to be posted as well as appropriate marking, all as provided above.

5. Any person, firm, or corporation violating any provision of this Ordinance shall be fined not less than Ten Dollars (\$10.00) nor more than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) for each offense.

6. That after the adoption and approval hereof the Ordinance shall (i) be printed or published in book or pamphlet form, published by the authority of the Council, or (ii) within thirty (30) days after the adoption and approval hereof, be published in a newspaper with a general circulation within the City of St. Charles.




