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TITLE 5, "BUSINESS LICENSES AND REGULATIONS",
CHAPTER 5.32, "REFUSE COLLECTORS", BY AMENDING
SECTION 5.32.015, "RECYCLING REQUIREMENT FOR
NON-RESIDENTIAL LICENSE HOLDERS", OF THE
ST. CHARLES MUNICIPAL CODE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ST. CHARLES,
KANE AND DU PAGE COUNTIES, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

1. That Title 5, "Business License and Regulations", Chapter 5.32 "Refuse Collectors", Section 5.32.015 "Recycling requirements for non-residential license holders" of the St. Charles Municipal Code, be and is hereby amended by lettering the first paragraph as "A" and by adding the following thereto:

"B. The Refuse Collector shall indemnify and hold harmless the City of St. Charles, Illinois, its employees and agents from and against any and all claims and demands whatsoever, including costs, litigation expenses, counsel fees and liabilities incurred in connection therewith, arising out of injury to, or death whatsoever, or damage to property of any kind by whomsoever owned, caused in whole or in part by the acts or omissions of the Refuse Collector, or any other person directly or indirectly employed by them, or any of them, while engaged in the performance of the work or any activity associated therewith or relative thereto."

2. That after the adoption and approval hereof the Ordinance shall (i) be printed or published in book or pamphlet form, published by the authority of the Council, or (ii) within thirty (30) days after the adoption and approval hereof, be published in a newspaper published in and with a general circulation within the City of St. Charles.


