ORDINANCE NO. 1992-M- 43

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 10, "VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC",
CHAPTER 10.40, "STOPPING, STANDING AND PARKING",
OF THE ST. CHARLES MUNICIPAL CODE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ST. CHARLES,
KANE AND DU PAGE COUNTIES, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

1. That Title 10, "Vehicles and Traffic", Chapter 10.40, "Stopping, Standing and Parking", of the St. Charles Municipal Code, be and is hereby amended by adding Section 10.40.042, "No-parking places designated - bus loading zones", as follows:

"10.40.042 No-parking places designated - bus loading zones.

It is unlawful for the operator or owner of any vehicle at any time to cause, allow, or permit any vehicle to stop, stand or park in any of the following places, which shall be designated as bus loading zones, on school days between the hours of 7AM and 4PM, except when necessary to avoid conflict with other traffic or in compliance with the directions of a police officer or official traffic control device:

- A. On the northerly side of Indiana Avenue from a point seventy-five feet easterly of the easterly right-of-way line of South Sixth Avenue to a point two hundred fifty feet easterly of the easterly right-of-way line of South Sixth Avenue.
- B. On the easterly side of South Thirteenth Avenue from the southerly right-of-way line of Ronzheimer Avenue to a point two hundred fifty feet south of the southerly right-of-way line of Ronzheimer Avenue.
- C. On the easterly side of south Twelfth Street from a point seventy-five feet northerly of the northerly right-of-way line of Oak Street to a point three hundred fifteen feet

northerly of the northerly right-of-way line of Oak Street.

- D. On the westerly side of south Seventh Street from a point two hundred twenty feet southerly of the southerly right-of-way line of Horne Street to a point three hundred ninety feet southerly of the southerly right-of-way line of Horne Street.
- E. On the easterly side of North Fifth Street from a point twenty-five feet northerly of the northerly right-of-way line of Cedar Street to the southerly right-of-way line of State Street.
- F. On the northerly side of Cedar Street from the easterly right-of-way line of North Fifth Street to a point one hundred five feet easterly of the easterly right-of-way line of North Fifth Street."

2. That the Director of Public Works or any other person authorized by the Mayor and City Council shall cause signs to be posted as provided herein.

3. Any person, firm, or corporation violating any provision of this Ordinance shall be fined not less than Ten Dollars (\$10.00) nor more than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) for each such offense; and a separate offense shall be deemed committed on each day during or on which a violation occurs or continues.

4. That after the adoption and approval hereof the Ordinance shall (i) be printed or published in book or pamphlet form, published by the authority of the Council, or (ii) within thirty (30) days after the adoption and approval hereof, be published in a newspaper published in and with a general circulation within the


