

ORDINANCE NO. 1993-M-55

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 10, "VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC",
CHAPTER 10.11, "RULES OF THE ROAD", SECTION 10.11.1710,
"AUTHORITY TO PLACE DEVICES ALTERING NORMAL COURSE FOR TURNS",
OF THE ST. CHARLES MUNICIPAL CODE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ST. CHARLES,
KANE AND DU PAGE COUNTIES ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

1. That Title 10, "Vehicles and Traffic", Chapter 10.11,
"Rules of the Road", Section 10.11.1710, "Authority to place
devices altering normal course for turns", of the St. Charles
Municipal Code, be and is hereby amended by deleting the same and
substituting the following therefor:

"10.11.1710 Authority to place devices altering
normal course for turns.

The city engineer is authorized to place official
traffic control devices within or adjacent to
intersections indicating the course to be traveled by
vehicles turning at such intersections, and such course
to be traveled as so indicated may conform to or be other
than as prescribed by law.

- A. A right turn is prohibited on red on First
Street at its intersection with Main Street
for traffic traveling northerly in the city.
- B. It is unlawful for the operator of any vehicle
to negotiate a left turn at the intersection
of Main Street and First Street in the city.
- C. It is unlawful for the operator of any vehicle
to negotiate a left turn into the drive or
exiting the drive which has a centerline
207.50 feet easterly of Hunt Club Drive."


2. Any person, firm or corporation violating any provision
of this ordinance shall be fined not less than ten dollars (\$10.00)
nor more than five hundred dollars (\$500.00) for each offense.

3. That after the adoption and approval hereof the Ordinance shall (i) be printed or published in book or pamphlet form, published by the authority of the Council, or (ii) within thirty (30) days after the adoption and approval hereof, be published in a newspaper published in and with a general circulation within the City of St. Charles.
