



ORDINANCE NO. 1996-M- 75

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 9.44,
"TRESPASS", OF THE ST. CHARLES MUNICIPAL CODE**

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ST. CHARLES, KANE AND DU PAGE COUNTIES, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Chapter 9.44 entitled, "Trespass", be and is hereby amended by adding Section 9.44.040, "Trespass to Public Property", as follows:

9.44.040 Trespass to Public Property.

A. Findings.

The corporate authorities of the city of St. Charles are advised that certain storm water retention areas within the city are natural wetland areas or are designed to resemble natural wetland areas and as such require protection from trespassers in order to preserve the natural character and functioning of the retention areas. The corporate authorities are further advised that prohibiting trespassing in such areas will protect the public from injury and infectious disease.

B. Trespass to Public Property Prohibited.

It shall be unlawful for any person to commit a trespass to the public area(s) described as Outlot "B" in Woods of Fox Glen Unit Two, in the City of St. Charles, Kane County, Illinois. All designated area(s) shall be clearly marked with permanent, fixed signs advising the public that the area is subject to regulation under the City of St. Charles No Trespassing Ordinance.

C. Violation - Penalty.

Any person, firm or corporation violating any provision of this Section shall be fined not more than five hundred dollars for each offense, and a separate offense be deemed committed on each day on which a violation occurs or continues.


Section 2. That after the adoption and approval hereof the Ordinance shall (l) be printed or published in book or pamphlet form, published by the authority of the Council,

or (ii) within thirty (30) days after the adoption and approval hereof, be published in a newspaper published in and with a general circulation within the City of St. Charles.




I further certify that on October 21, 1996, the Corporate Authorities of such municipality passed and approved Ordinance No. 1996-M-75, entitled
