ORDINANCE NO. 2001-M- 4

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 5
"BUSINESS LICENSES AND REGULATIONS" CHAPTER 5.12
"AMUSEMENTS," SECTIONS 5.12.200 "BOWLING ALLEY-LICENSE FEE"
ON SECTIONS 5.12.210 "BOWLING ALLEY-HOURS OF OPERATION"
OF THE CHARLES MUNICIPAL CODE**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ST.
CHARLES, KANE AND DUPAGE COUNTIES, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:**

1. That Title 5 "Business Licenses and Regulations" Chapter 5.12 "Amusements" Sections 5.12.200 "Bowling Alley-License Fee" and Section 5.12.210 "Bowling Alley-Hours of Operation" of the St. Charles Municipal Code shall be amended to read as follows:

A. Section 5.12.200 "Bowling Alley-Licensee" shall read as follows:

The annual fee for such bowling alley licenses shall be \$25.00 for each alley;

B. Section 5.12.210 "Bowling Alley-Hours of Operation" shall read as follows:

No person shall keep open, operate or use any such alley between the hours of 1:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m. on Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday. No person shall keep open, operate or use any such alley between the hours of 2:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m. on a Saturday or Sunday.

Notwithstanding the above, a licensed bowling alley may secure the written permission of the City Administrator or the Chief of Police to operate in the above prohibited hours on a not-for-profit basis for private uses when the bowling alley is not open to the general public.

2. That after the adoption and approval hereof, this Ordinance shall (i) be printed or published in book or pamphlet form published by the authority of the Council, or (ii) within thirty

(30) days after the adoption and approval hereof, be published in a newspaper published in and with a general circulation within the City of St. Charles.

3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by a vote of the majority of the corporate authorities now holding office and approval in the manner provided by law.


