

ORDINANCE NO. 2002 – M – 94

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 8, "HEALTH and SAFETY", CHAPTER 8.24,
"GARBAGE and REFUSE",

OF THE ST. CHARLES MUNICIPAL CODE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ST. CHARLES,

KANE AND DUPAGE COUNTIES AS FOLLOWS:

1. THAT TITLE 8, "HEALTH and SAFETY", CHAPTER 8.24, "GARBAGE and REFUSE" of the St. Charles Municipal Code be and is hereby amended by deleting SECTION 8.24.026, "Non-residential collection", and inserting the following therefore:

"8.24.026 Non-residential collection.

- A. General requirements. All owners and occupiers of non-residential structures in the City shall collect and dispose accumulations of garbage and refuse, recyclable material and material regularly and systematically, at least once every fourteen days, by a refuse collector licensed by the city pursuant to Chapter 5.32.011 of the St. Charles Municipal Code. Containers to be used for the collection of garbage and refuse from non-residential premises shall be tightly covered metal or other non-corrodible, watertight containers. All hotels, motels, restaurants, industrial categories, hospitals, food take out and catering kitchens, food stands, schools, churches, convents, grocery and meat markets, and all other establishments having disposable garbage, refuse and recyclables shall store such garbage, refuse and recyclables in containers with covers of suitable size until the designated pickup days. Mobile garbage and refuse containers required to be left at curb side shall be placed at curb side no earlier than 5:00 p.m. on the day preceding the day on which collection is scheduled, and shall be removed from curb side no later than 5:00 p.m. on the day of collection.
- B. Walnut court service area. Property owners and tenants in the service area generally described as the block bounded by West Main Street on the North, First Street

on the East, Walnut Street on South and Second Street on the West shall deposit all garbage, refuse, and recyclables in approved containers designated by the City. Property owners and tenants shall pay to the City the scavenger's pick up fee in accordance with the terms and conditions of the City contract with the licensed scavenger. Deposit of garbage, refuse or recyclable materials on the ground or in unapproved containers is expressly prohibited.

In addition, the following sections shall apply to all non-residential premises: Section 8.24.010 ("Definitions"); Section 8.24.050 ("Uncovered garbage"); Section 8.24.055 ("Depositing garbage or refuse on another's property"); Section 8.24.060 ("Wind-blown dust, ashes or trash"); Section 8.24.070 ("Deposit on streets"); Section 8.24.080 ("Consent of owner"); Section 8.24.090 ("Title to wastes"); Section 8.24.099 ("Enforcement"); Section 8.24.100 ("Penalty for violation of Chapter 8.24"). (Ord. 1990-M-10 § 1)."

2. That after the adoption and approval hereof, this Ordinance shall (a) be printed and published in book or pamphlet form, published by the authority of the City Council, or (b) within thirty (30) days after the adoption and approval hereof, be published in a newspaper published in and with a general circulation within the City of St. Charles.
