**An Ordinance Amending Title 10 "Vehicles and Traffic,"
Chapter 10.11 "Rules of the Road," Section 10.11.2370, "Riding in the
business district" of the St. Charles Municipal Code**

WHEREAS, A section of the Fox River Trail bike route, along 1st Avenue (Riverside Avenue) from Illinois Avenue to State Avenue, has long been a source of conflict between cyclists, pedestrians and motorists; and,

WHEREAS, the City worked with a sub-committee of the Downtown Partnership Traffic and Parking Committee:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ST. CHARLES, KANE AND DUPAGE COUNTIES, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

1. That Title 10, "Vehicles and Traffic," Chapter 10.11 "Rules of the Road," Section 10.11.2370, "Riding in the business district," of the St. Charles Municipal Code, be and is hereby amended by deleting the same and substituting the following therefore:

10.11.2370 Riding in business district.

- A. No person shall ride a skateboard in the City upon a sidewalk or other City property within the boundaries of Special Service Area 1B except as specified in this section. For the purposes of this section, "Special Service Area 1B" shall mean the geographic area generally bounded by 5th Avenue on the east, 5th Street on the west, Prairie Street on the south and the railroad tracks/bridge to the north, and as fully set forth in the map attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.
- B. No person shall ride a bicycle upon the sidewalk on Main Street between the east curblineline of Second Avenue and the west curblineline of Third Street.
- C. No person shall ride a bicycle upon the sidewalk on 1st Avenue (Riverside Avenue) between the north curblineline of Illinois Ave and the south curblineline of Cedar Avenue Street
- D. The Director of Public Works shall place, erect and maintain signs prohibiting the use of skateboards as specified in subparagraph A, B and C above, in such locations identified by the Chief of Police.


2. That after the adoption and approval hereof the Ordinance shall (i) be printed or published in book or pamphlet form, published by the authority of the Council, or (ii) within thirty (30) days after the adoption and approval hereof, be published in a newspaper published in and with a general circulation within the City of St. Charles.


