ORDINANCE 1967-12

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTIONS ONE, THREE AND FIVE OF ORDINANCE NUMBER 1965-7 DATED MARCH 15, 1965, CREATING ST. CHARLES COMMUNITY YOUTH COMMISSION.

THAT WHEREAS, it has been found that ten members of such Commission are unnecessary and unworkable and the number should be reduced to five members.

THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ST. CHARLES, KANE COUNTY, ILLINOIS:

SECTION 1: That the St. Charles Community Youth Commission from and after May 1, 1967, shall consist of five members who shall be residents of the City of St. Charles.

SECTION 3: That the five members of such Commission shall be appointed by the Mayor with the approval of the City Council commencing as of May 1, 1967, the Chairman to be elected by the Commission from its own membership. The Commission shall elect as many officers as it may choose.

SECTION 5: The terms of the members of the Commission shall be for one year after the term of any present commissioners may have expired.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage ^{approval} and publication as prescribed by law.
