BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ST.  
CHARLES, KANE AND DU PAGE COUNTIES, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

1. That Chapter 2.04, "City Council", Section  
2.04.040, "Aldermen - Salary", of the St. Charles Municipal  
Code, be and is hereby deleted and the following substituted  
therefor:

2.04.040 Aldermen - Salary.

Each alderman that is elected and takes  
office on or after April 5, 1983 shall be  
paid a salary of Seventy Five Dollars for  
each regular, special or adjourned council  
meeting as required by law. The current  
aldermen of the council, and any others who  
shall complete the unexpired terms of current  
aldermen, shall serve out their remaining  
terms, after such date, at the current salary  
of Fifty Dollars for each regular, special  
or adjourned council meeting. Until April 5,  
1983 each alderman shall continue to receive  
the current salary of Fifty Dollars for each  
regular, special or adjourned council meeting.

2. That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect  
from and after its passage, approval and publication in  
accordance with law.


