



ORDINANCE NO. 2004-M- 11

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 2, "ADMINISTRATION AND PERSONNEL,"  
CHAPTER 2.04, "CITY COUNCIL,"  
OF THE ST. CHARLES MUNICIPAL CODE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ST. CHARLES, KANE  
AND DU PAGE COUNTIES, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

1. That Title 2, "Administration and Personnel," Chapter 2.04, "City Council,"  
Section 2.04.020, "Meetings – Time and Place," of the St. Charles Municipal Code, be and is hereby  
amended by deleting the same and substituting the following therefor:

**2.04.020 Meetings – Time and Place.**

The regular meetings of the City Council shall be held at the St. Charles municipal center on the first and third Mondays of every month at the hour of seven o'clock p.m., provided that if the regular meeting falls on a Federal holiday, listed as follows, the meeting shall take place on the next secular day at the same hour:

- the 1st day of January, commonly known as New Year's Day;
- the 3rd Monday in January, commonly known as Martin Luther King Jr. Day;
- the 3rd Monday in February, commonly known as Presidents' Day;
- the 30th day of May, commonly known as Memorial Day;
- the 4th day of July, commonly known as Independence Day;
- the 1st Monday in September, commonly known as Labor Day;
- the 2<sup>nd</sup> Monday in October, commonly known as Columbus Day;
- the 11<sup>th</sup> day of November, commonly known as Veteran's Day;
- the 25th day of December, commonly known as Christmas Day;


When any such holidays fall on Sunday, the Monday next following shall be held and considered such holiday. Adjourned meetings may be held at such time as the city council may determine.

2. That after the adoption and approval hereof the Ordinance shall (i) be printed or published in book or pamphlet form, published by the authority of the Council, or (ii) within thirty (30) days after the adoption and approval hereof, be published in a newspaper published in and with a general circulation within the City of St. Charles. This ordinance shall be effective as of March 1, 2004.
