**Ordinance No. 2011-M- 2**

**An Ordinance Amending Title 2, "Administration and Personnel,"  
Chapter 2.04, "City Council," Section 2.04.020, "Meetings – Time and  
Place" of the St. Charles Municipal Code**

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the City Council of the City of St. Charles, Kane and DuPage Counties, Illinois as follows:

**SECTION ONE:** That Title 2, "Administration and Personnel", Chapter 2.04, "City Council", Section 2.04.020, "Meetings – Time and Place" of the St. Charles Municipal Code be and is hereby deleted in its entirety and in lieu thereof, the following language shall be substituted:

**2.04.020 Meetings – Time and place.**

The regular meetings of the City Council shall be held at the St. Charles Municipal Center on the first and third Mondays of every month at the hour of seven (7:00) o'clock p.m., provided that if the regular meeting falls on a Federal holiday, listed as follows, the meeting shall take place on the next secular day at the same hour:

- the 1<sup>st</sup> day of January, commonly called New Year's Day;
- the 3<sup>rd</sup> Monday in January, commonly known as Martin Luther King Jr. Day;
- the 3<sup>rd</sup> Monday in February, commonly known as Presidents' Day;
- the 4<sup>th</sup> day of July, commonly known as Independence Day (as observed);
- the 1<sup>st</sup> Monday in September, commonly known as Labor Day;
- the 11<sup>th</sup> day of November, commonly known as Veterans Day;
- the 25<sup>th</sup> day of December, commonly called Christmas Day (as observed).

When any such holidays fall on Sunday, the Monday next following shall be held and considered such holiday. Adjourned meetings may be held at such time as the City Council may determine."

**SECTION TWO:** That after the adoption and approval hereof this Ordinance shall be printed or published in book or pamphlet form, published by the authority of the City Council.


