



An Ordinance Amending Title 2, "Administration and Personnel," Chapter 2.24 "Fire and Police Commissioners," Section 2.24.010 "Created – Composition" of the St. Charles Municipal Code

WHEREAS, Chapter 2.24, Section 2.24.010 of the St. Charles Municipal Code currently provides for a Board of Fire and Police Commissioners consisting of five members; and,

WHEREAS, there are two vacancies on the Board of Fire and Police Commissioners at the present time, leaving only three members remaining to conduct business; and,

WHEREAS, the City has determined that it is in the best interests of the City to reduce the composition of the Board of Fire and Police Commissioners to three members, thereby facilitating the conduct of business.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ST. CHARLES, KANE AND DUPAGE COUNTIES, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE: That Title 2, "Administration and Personnel", Chapter 2.24, "Fire and Police Commissioners", Section 2.24.010, "Created – Composition", of the St. Charles Municipal Code, be and the same is hereby deleted in its entirety and in lieu thereof the following language shall be substituted:

"2.24.010 Created – Composition.

There is hereby created a board of fire and police commissioners consisting of three members. They shall be officers of the municipality, as provided by statute."

SECTION TWO: That the three members of the Board of Fire and Police Commissioners currently holding office on the effective date of this Ordinance, shall constitute the Board of Fire and Police Commissioners. Said members shall continue to hold office in accordance with their respective terms of office.

SECTION THREE: That after the adoption and approval hereof, this Ordinance shall (i) be printed or published in book or pamphlet form pursuant to the authority of the City Council, or (ii) within thirty (30) days after the adoption and approval hereof, be

published in a newspaper published in and with a general circulation within the City of St. Charles.

SECTION FOUR: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect ten (10) days from and after its passage by a vote of the majority of the corporate authorities now holding office, approval and publication in the manner provided by law.


