

Ordinance No. 1961-29

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE ZONING ORDINANCE
OF THE CITY OF ST. CHARLES, ILLINOIS, ADOPTED
MAY 23, 1960, AND KNOWN AS ORDINANCE NO. 1960-16

WHEREAS, a petition was filed by Jules Tant with the City Council of the City of St. Charles, Illinois, petitioning for a special use under Section VIII, B-3 Service Business District, for a coin operated dry cleaning establishment as under Paragraph 3-F, and

WHEREAS, said petition was referred to the Zoning Board of Appeals, and the said Board of Appeals did publish notice for hearings to be held on such petition and the Zoning Board of Appeals did hold hearings on such Resolution, all in accordance with the Statutes and Ordinances in such cases made and provided, and

WHEREAS, the Zoning Board of Appeals has recommended the enactment of the following Ordinance, and

WHEREAS, it is to the best interest of the City of St. Charles, Illinois, that the Zoning Ordinance adopted on May 23, 1960, and known as Number 1960-16, be amended as hereinafter set forth:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ST. CHARLES, ILLINOIS, that the Zoning Ordinance of the City of St. Charles, Illinois, adopted on May 23, 1960, and known as Number 1960-16 be and the same is hereby amended to add to Section VIII, B-3 Service Business District, Paragraph 3-F be amended to include Coin Operated Dry Cleaning Establishments.
