

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ARTICLE III, CHAPTER 15
OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF ST. CHARLES, ILLINOIS, 1965.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ST.
CHARLES, KANE COUNTY, ILLINOIS;

That Paragraph 15.305a, Rates, of Chapter 15, Water, of
the Municipal Code of 1965, shall be amended to read as follows:

a.) Sale within City Limits. The following rates
shall be charged for water sold to persons residing within the
city limits:

For the first 3,000 gallons or any amount less than
3,000 gallons, the sum of \$3.50.

For each 1,000 gallons in excess of 3,000 gallons
up to and including 30,000 gallons, the sum of 48 cents.

For each 1,000 gallons in excess of 30,000 gallons
up to and including 70,000 gallons, the sum of 42 cents.

For each 1,000 gallons in excess of 70,000 gallons
the sum of 29 cents.

That this amendment to the Municipal Code shall be
in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval,
and publication, as is by law required.
