

ORDINANCE 1966-14

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 7 OF
THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF ST. CHARLES, ILLINOIS, 1965.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ST. CHARLES,
KANE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, that Chapter 7 of the Municipal Code of St. Charles,
Illinois, shall be amended to add the following section:

CHAPTER 7 - POLICE DEPARTMENT

7.011 (Legal Holidays) Each member of the department shall
receive seven legal holidays per year. These holidays shall
be known as New Year's Day, Memorial Day, the Fourth of July,
Labor Day, Veterans Day, Thanksgiving Day and Christmas Day.
That these legal holidays shall be allowed off at the discretion
of the Chief.

This amendment to the Ordinance shall be in full force and effect
from and after its passage and approval.
