

ORDINANCE 1968-13

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 25, ARTICLE IX, SCAVENGERS, OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF ST. CHARLES, ILLINOIS, 1965.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ST. CHARLES, KANE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, that Chapter 25, Article IX, Scavengers, shall be amended to read as follows:

Article IX Scavengers.

25.901 (License Required)

It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to engage in the business of scavenger, or the collection or disposal of animal, human or vegetable refuse, or offal, or refuse of any kind without having first secured a license therefore. A license may not be assigned, transferred or conveyed in any manner without the consent and approval of the Mayor and City Council of the City of St. Charles, Illinois.

25.902 (Applications)

Annual application for such license shall be made to the City Clerk, prior to May first of each calendar year, and shall be referred by him to the Mayor and City Council for recommendation; no such license shall be issued except on order of the Mayor and City Council. No more than four (4) scavenger's licenses shall be in force in the City of St. Charles at any one time. Each scavenger must file with the City Clerk of the City of the City of St. Charles a list of its charges for commercial, business and industrial establishments on or before May first, of each calendar year.

25.903 (Fee)

The annual fee for such license shall be Two Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$250.00).

25.904 (Vehicles)

Any vehicle used by such scavenger in his business shall be water tight and equipped with airtight covers for such portions as are used for the transportation of garbage or similar refuse. It shall be unlawful for any such vehicle to be driven over or through any street in the City during or on Sunday.

25.905 (Disposal)

It shall be unlawful for any scavenger to dispose of or store any refuse in any place within the city limits or within one mile and one half thereof, excepting with the permission of the Mayor and City Council.

25.906 (Penalty)

Any person, firm or corporation violating any provision of this article shall be fined not less than Five Dollars (\$5.00) nor more than Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) for each offense; and a separate offense shall be deemed committed on each day during or on which a violation occurs or continues.

This amendment to the Municipal Code shall take effect from and after its passage, signing and publication pursuant to law.
