

ORDINANCE 1968-19

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 27 OF THE
MUNICIPAL CODE TO REDEFINE THE MISDEMEANOR OF "CURFEW"

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ST. CHARLES,
KANE COUNTY, ILLINOIS.

Section 1. That Section 27.101 and 27.102 of Chapter 27 of the Municipal Code of 1965 entitled "Curfew" be, and the same hereby is, amended by repealing the existing Sections 27.101 and 27.102 in their entirety and inserting in lieu thereof, the following:

27.101 Children on Streets at Night. It is unlawful for a person less than 18 years of age to be present at or upon any public assembly, building, place, street or highway at the following times unless accompanied and supervised by a parent, legal guardian or other responsible companion at least 21 years of age approved by a parent or legal guardian or unless engaged in a business or occupation which the laws of this State authorize a person less than 18 years of age to perform.

A. Between 12:01 A.M. and 6:00 A.M. Saturday

B. Between 12:01 A.M. and 6:00 A.M. Sunday and between 11:00 P.M. on Sunday to Thursday inclusive and 6:00 A.M. on the following day.

27.102 Permitting Child to Violate Curfew. It is unlawful for a parent, legal guardian or other person to knowingly permit a person in his custody or control to violate sub-section 27.101 of this Chapter.

Section 2. That all other ordinances or parts thereof in conflict herewith be, and the same hereby are, repealed and of no further force and effect.

Section 3. That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication.
