ORDINANCE NO. 1970-M-20

ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 12, SECTION 12.107 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF ST. CHARLES, ILLINOIS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ST. CHARLES, ILLINOIS, that the Municipal Code of the City of St. Charles, Illinois, as amended from time to time, is further amended at Chapter 12, Section 12.107 as follows:

"12.107 Obstructions.) It shall be unlawful for any firm, corporation, or person to cause, create, maintain, or permit the obstruction of any street, alley, sidewalk, or public way in such a manner that it interferes with the free use and access of such public way, except as may be specifically authorized by ordinance or by the Superintendent of Public Works."

"Any person or persons who shall be at any time found standing, walking, or sitting in a public way in such a manner as to prevent the use or access to such public way to other members of the public and who shall refuse to disburse or clear the public way and leave the area and clear said public way when requested to do so by any member of the Police Department or by any person annoyed thereby, shall be presumed to be intentionally obstructing said street, alley, sidewalk, or public way."

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and after due publication.
