

ORDINANCE NO. 1973-M-1

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE  
CITY OF ST. CHARLES, ILLINOIS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ST. CHARLES,  
KANE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, that the Municipal Code of the City of St. Charles,  
Illinois, as amended from time to time, is further amended as follows:

I. Chapter 15 entitled "Water", Section 15.105 entitled, "Service  
Connection Fees", shall be amended to read as follows:

"15.105 Service connection fees.)

A. Residential--the connection fee shall be \$160.00 per  
unit plus the following for such services:

For a 3/4" tap	100.00
For a 1" tap	130.00
For a 1 1/4" tap	160.00
For a 1 1/2" tap	195.00
For a 2" tap	260.00

For taps larger than 2", the charge shall be the cost  
to the city for making such tap.

No connection shall be made by any person not authorized  
by the Superintendent of Public Works to perform such service.

After payment of the above stipulated fees, the City Water  
Department shall furnish and install a corporation cock, the  
service pipe to the curb stop, and the curb stop and buffalo box.  
These aforementioned items and services shall be furnished only  
after suitable trench excavation has been provided by the  
customer or his licensed contractor. The customer shall also  
be responsible for the proper back-filling of the trench and  
any necessary patching--sidewalk, curb or paving.

Definition: A "unit" is a single family residence or each  
apartment in an apartment building or other multiple  
dwelling or each trailer space in a trailer park or each room  
in a motel or hotel and is to be considered a residential area  
including sleeping and toilet facilities."

B. Commercial and Industrial--the connection fee shall be \$ .35 per gallon per day of estimated usage subject to a minimum of \$160.00 plus the following for such service:

For a 3/4" tap	100.00
For a 1" tap	130.00
For a 1 1/4" tap	160.00
For a 1 1/2" tap	195.00
For a 2" tap	260.00

For taps larger than 2", the charge shall be the cost to the city for making such tap.

No connection shall be made by any person not authorized by the Superintendent of Public Works to perform such service.

After payment of the above stipulated fees, the City Water Department shall furnish and install a corporation cock, the service pipe to the curb stop, and the curb stop and buffalo box. These aforementioned items and services shall be furnished only after suitable trench excavation has been provided by the customer or his licensed contractor. The customer shall also be responsible for the proper back-filling of the trench and any necessary patching--sidewalk, curb or paving.

Estimated usage shall be determined by the City and user. Once the actual usage begins and it is determined that the actual usage has increased over the estimated usage, there will then be an additional fee for that amount over the original estimated usage based on \$ .35 per gallon per day. There will be no rebates if the actual use falls below the estimated usage.

II. Chapter 17, entitled "Sewers," Section 17.102 entitled "Connection Fees," shall be amended to read at part "C" as follows:

"C. Industrial and Commercial

1. Sewage Treatment Connection Fee: \$ .40 per gallon per day of estimated usage. Estimated usage shall be determined by the City and user. Once the actual usage begins and it is determined that the actual usage has increased over the estimated usage, there will be an additional fee for that amount over the original estimated usage based on \$ .40 per gallon per day subject to a minimum of \$160.00. There will be no rebates if the actual use falls below the estimated usage.

2. Sanitary Trunk Line: \$200.00 per acre of site.

3. Storm Trunk Line: \$200.00 per acre of site unless appropriate

"on site" storm water detention is provided and approved by the City of St. Charles.

III. Chapter 14 entitled "Electricity" shall be amended as follows:


1. That the electrical distribution connecting fee heretofore passed (Ordinance 1972-M-42) will be designated as the "Residential Electrical Distribution Connection Fee."
2. That there will be added a "Commercial and Industrial Electrical Distribution Connection Fee" of \$10.00 per kilowatt hour of estimated usage for new construction which is a one time charge.
3. Estimated usage shall be determined by the City and user. Once the actual usage begins and it is determined that the actual usage has increased over the estimated usage, there will then be an additional fee for that amount over the original estimated usage based on \$10.00 per kilowatt hour subject to a minimum charge of \$120.00. There will be no rebates if the actual use falls below the estimated usage.
4. It shall be unlawful to make any connection with the city electrical distribution system without having first obtained a permit therefor.
5. Any person, firm or corporation violating any provision of this chapter shall be fined not less than \$1.00 nor more than \$500.00 for each offense and a separate offense shall be deemed committed on each day that a violation occurs or continues.


These amendments to the Municipal Code shall take effect from and after the final passage, signing, and publication according to law.
