

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 14 OF THE
ST. CHARLES MUNICIPAL CODE OF 1965 ENTITLED
"ELECTRICITY"

WHEREAS, there has been an increase in the cost of purchasing electricity from Commonwealth Edison Company by the City of St. Charles as a result of a ruling by the Federal Power Commission; and

WHEREAS, the effective date of the said increase in cost of electricity is October 31, 1974, which will result in an increase in cost to the City of St. Charles of one million dollars per year; and

WHEREAS, the Federal Power Commission has refused to grant a delay or extension of the effective date of said increase in cost of electricity; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City of St. Charles that there be an increase in the energy charge that is imposed upon its electrical customers; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City of St. Charles that this Ordinance providing for an increase in energy charge take effect immediately upon its passage to alleviate the financial burden of the City of St. Charles as a result of the aforementioned increase in the cost to the City of St. Charles.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of St. Charles, Illinois that the following paragraphs of Chapter 14 entitled "Electricity" of the St. Charles Municipal Code be amended so that they shall hereafter read as follows:

SECTION I

"Paragraph A Rate 1 - Residential

200 kilowatthours.....	3.80 cents per kwh
For all over

SECTION II

"Paragraph B Rate 2 - Residential Space Heating

2. Energy Charge

a. Net Charge

for the first	
50 kilowatthours.....	8.00 cents per kwh
For the next	
50 kilowatthours.....	5.50 cents per kwh
For the next	
200 kilowatthours.....	3.80 cents per kwh
For all over	
300 kilowatthours.....	1.35 cents per kwh."

SECTION III

"Paragraph C Rate 3 - Commercial

2. Energy Charge

a. Net Charge:

For the first	
100 kilowatthours.....	6.00 cents per kwh
For the next	
4,900 kilowatthours.....	4.45 cents per kwh
For the next	
10,000 kilowatthours.....	3.50 cents per kwh
For the next	
15,000 kilowatthours.....	3.20 cents per kwh
For all over	
30,000 kilowatthours.....	2.70 cents per kwh."

SECTION IV

"Paragraph D Rate 4 - Central Commercial District

100 kilowatthours.....	7.75 cents per kwh
For the next	
4,900 kilowatthours.....	4.65 cents per kwh
For the next	
10,000 kilowatthours.....	3.50 cents per kwh
For the next	
15,000 kilowatthours.....	3.20 cents per kwh
For all ver	
30,000 kilowatthours.....	2.70 cents per kwh."

SECTION V

"Paragraph E. Rate 5 - Industrial

2. Energy Charge:

a. Net Charge:

For the first	
10,000 kilowatthours.....	3.00 cents per kwh
For the next	
90,000 kilowatthours.....	2.70 cents per kwh
For the next	
300,000 kilowatthours.....	2.50 cents per kwh
For all over	
400,000 kilowatthours.....	2.01 cents per kwh."

SECTION VI

"Paragraph G Supplementary Rate 6 - Commercial Electric Space Heating

b. This rate is available only in conjunction with the City's standard rates 3-Commercial, 4-Central Commercial District, and 5-Industrial.

2. Energy Charge:

a. Subject to the provisions set forth in the following paragraph entitled "Combined Heating and Cooling Facilities," the charge for electric service supplied for space heating under this rate shall be the sum of 1.35 cents net per kilowatthour and the applicable fuel adjustment charge."

SECTION VII

This ordinance shall take effect immediatily upon its passage by an affirmative vote of 2/3's of all members of the corporate authorities now holding office.
