AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE ST. CHARLES
MUNICIPAL CODE TO PROHIBIT CAMPING ON CITY
PROPERTY BETWEEN THE MAIN STREET BRIDGE AND THE
RAILROAD TRESTLE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ST. CHARLES,
ILLINOIS, that Chapter 28 of the St. Charles Municipal Code is hereby
amended to add 28.042 which shall read as follows:

"28.042 Camping.) It shall be unlawful for any person or
persons to camp at any time on City property between the Main
Street bridge and the railroad trestle. Camping shall include
building a fire or partaking of any meal or the maintenance of
a rendezvous or meeting place and shall further include the use
of any vehicle having a compact temporary living unit which sits
in the bed of a pickup truck or use of any part of a vehicle or
apparatus for shelter or resting.

The Superintendent of Public Works is hereby authorized to erect
the appropriate signs prohibiting camping.

Any person violating this Ordinance shall be fined not less than
\$5.00 nor more than \$500.00 for each offense.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after
its passage, approval and publication as is required by law.
