

ORDINANCE NO. 1975-M- 38
AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 14 OF THE
ST. CHARLES MUNICIPAL CODE OF 1965
ENTITLED "ELECTRICITY"

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL of the City of St. Charles, Illinois that the following paragraphs of Chapter 14 entitled "Electricity" of the St. Charles Municipal Code be amended so that they shall hereafter read as follows:

"14.104 Rates, Paragraph A Rate 1 Residential, 2 Energy Charge

2A. Monthly Customer Charge - The net monthly customer charge shall be \$1.40.

2B. Energy Charge -

<u>NET</u>	<u>kilowatt hours supplied in the month</u>
\$.0399 per kilowatt hour for the first	100
\$.0294 per kilowatt hour for the next	400
\$.0345 per kilowatt hour for the next	500
\$.0395 per kilowatt hour for all over	1,000

"14.104 Rates Paragraph B Rate 2 Residential Space Heating, 2 Energy Charge.

2A. Monthly Customer Charge - The net monthly customer charge shall be \$1.40.

2B. Energy Charge -

<u>NET</u>	<u>kilowatt hours supplied in the month</u>
\$.0399 per kilowatt hour for the first	100
\$.0294 per kilowatt hour for the next	400
\$.0345 per kilowatt hour for the next	100
\$.0140 per kilowatt hour for all over	600

except that the net charge shall be \$.0325 per kilowatt hour for all use over 600 kilowatt hours per month in the first monthly billing period with an ending meter reading date on or after June 15 and in the three succeeding monthly billing periods."

"14.104 Rates Paragraph D Rate 4 Central Commercial District, 2B Demand Charge.

2B Demand Charge -

For the purposes hereof the "summer months" shall be the Customer's first monthly billing period with an ending meter reading date on or after June 15 and the three succeeding monthly billing periods.

For customers without demand meters, there shall be no demand charge as such, but, in lieu thereof, such customer shall pay 1.71 cents per kilowatt hour in addition to the net energy charges set forth below.

"14.104 Rates Paragraph E. Rate 5 Commercial/Industrial, 2B Demand Charges.

For the purposes hereof the "summer Months" shall be the Customer's first monthly billing period with an ending meter reading date on or after June 15 and the three succeeding monthly billing periods.

For customers without demand meters, there shall be no demand charge as such, but, in lieu thereof, such customer shall pay 1.71 cents per kilowatt hour in addition to the net energy charges set forth below.

"14.104 Rates Paragraph G Rate 6 Commercial/Industrial Electric Space Heating, 2 Energy Charge.

2. Energy Charge -

a. Subject to the provisions set forth in the following paragraph entitled "Combined Heating and Cooling Facilities", the charge for electric service supplied for space heating under this rate shall be (a) the sum of \$.0140 cents net per kilowatt hour and the applicable fuel adjustment charge or (b) the charges, under the customer's rate, for adding such service to the service otherwise supplied to the customer.

For the purpose of applying demand charge discount, demands

added by space heating facilities in the months previous to the billing month shall not be included in the maximum demands for such months unless (b) of the preceding sentence is operative in the billing month and then only in the previous months in which (b) was operative.

In computing the gross charge, if applicable, the amount to be added to net charges shall be computed under the customer's rate as though this rider were not in effect but the amount added with respect to billings under (a) above shall not exceed five percent of such billings.

5. General -

Except as specified above in this paragraph "G", supplementary Rate 6, Commercial Electric Space Heating, all other provisions of the standard rate which this supplementary rate is in conjunction with, shall apply."

"14.104 Paragraph F, All Rates - Fuel Adjustment

A fuel adjustment charge or credit shall be applicable to all kilowatt hours supplied in the month. The charge or credit per kilowatt hour will be designated on the bill. The fuel adjustment figure used shall be identical to that paid by the City on its prior month's invoice for electrical energy supplied by Commonwealth Edison Company, increased by \$.00352 per kilowatt hour or such other cost per kilowatt hour as may be authorized by the Federal Power Commission to be added to the Commonwealth Edison wholesale cost per kilowatt hour to specifically offset a decrease in the fuel adjustment charge as stipulated in Rider 20 as approved by the Federal Power Commission.

Due to an amendment of the Federal Power Commission, Rider 20 which modifies rate structure made by Commonwealth Edison to the City, it is necessary and in the best interest of the City that this modified rate structure be applied to all users of the electric utility and this ordinance will take effect immediately on its passage, provided that 2/3 of the members of the corporate authorities then holding office, so direct.
