ORDINANCE NO. 1976-M-18
 AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 14 ENTITLED
 "ELECTRICITY" OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF
 ST. CHARLES, ILLINOIS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ST. CHARLES,
 ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

1. That Chapter 14 entitled "Electricity", Article 105, entitled
 "Terms and Conditions", paragraph 16 entitled "Residential Electrical
 Distribution Connection Fee" is hereby amended so that it shall
 hereafter read as follows:

"16. Residential Electrical Distribution Connection Fee.

a. There is hereby established an electrical distribution
 connection fee of \$175.00 per unit.

b. Definition: a "unit" is a single family residence or
 each apartment in an apartment building or other multiple
 dwelling or each trailer space in a trailer park or each
 room in a motel or hotel and is to be considered a residential
 area including sleeping and toilet facilities."

2. That Article 105, Paragraph 17 entitled "Commercial and
 Industrial Electrical Distribution Connection Fee" is hereby amended
 so that Paragraph 17C as to the minimum connection fee shall read:

"The minimum fee shall be \$175.00."

This ordinance shall become effective upon its approval,
 passage and publication pursuant to law.
