

ORDINANCE 1976-M-42

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 24, ENTITLED
"DEALERS IN INTOXICATING LIQUORS" OF THE
MUNICIPAL CODE OF ST. CHARLES OF 1965

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ST.
CHARLES, ILLINOIS THAT the above captioned Ordinance is hereby amended
as follows:

"24.029 License Classes and Fees:

11. Class K licenses shall authorize all Class B, C, E and F license holders who desire to provide live entertainment on any Saturday night until 2:00 A.M. Sunday to hold a Supplemental Entertainment License. Live entertainment shall mean an instrumental group of three or more persons. The yearly fee for said Supplemental License shall be \$200.00."

"24.033.C. Special Hours for Supplemental Entertainment Licenses:

All establishments having Supplemental Entertainment Licenses are permitted to remain open until 2:00 A.M. on Sunday following any Saturday night they are providing live entertainment pursuant to this ordinance."

This ordinance shall become effective upon its passage, approval and publication pursuant to law.
