AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ARTICLE V ENTITLED
 OTHER REGULATIONS PERTAINING TO HEALTH OF
 THE ST. CHARLES MUNICIPAL CODE TO ADD SECTION
19.517 NOTIFICATION OF TREATMENT OF CERTAIN INJURIES

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of St. Charles, Illinois that Article V entitled Other Regulations Pertaining to Health of the St. Charles Municipal Code is hereby amended to add Section 19.517 entitled NOTIFICATION OF TREATMENT OF CERTAIN INJURIES which shall hereafter read as follows:

"19.517 Notification of Treatment of Certain Injuries.) It shall be the duty of any person, firm or corporation conducting or operating a medical facility or any physician, nurse or employee thereof as soon as time permits giving due consideration to the treatment for any injury hereinafter specified to notify the St. Charles Police Department when any person seeking treatment from the injuries hereinafter specified, who is not accompanied by a St. Charles Police Officer or an officer from another police agency, when it reasonably appears the person requesting treatment has received (a.) an injury resulting from the discharge of a firearm; (b.) any injury or wound apparently inflicted by any object used as a weapon; (c.) an injury sustained in the commission of or as a victim of a criminal offense; (d.) any animal or human bite; (e.) any poisoning; (f.) any injury sustained on public property; (g.) any injury in which a moving motor vehicle was involved; (h.) any injury of any cause where it is evident that death will probably ensue as a direct result thereof, or when death has resulted; (i) any child that has suffered injury or disability from physical abuse, or neglect inflicted upon him or her or shows evidence of malnutrition, other than by accidental means.

Any hospital, physician, nurse or employee thereof, shall be held harmless for their reasonable compliance with this ordinance, and shall not be held responsible for inaccurate information being given by the patient or those accompanying the patient."

Any person, firm, or corporation violating this ordinance shall be fined not less than \$1.00 nor more than \$500.00 for each offense. This ordinance shall become effective on its passage, approval and publication pursuant to law.
