ORDINANCE NO. 1977-M-17

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 25 SECTION 25.902 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF ST. CHARLES, ILLINOIS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ST. CHARLES, ILLINOIS, that Chapter 25, entitled "other Businesses Licensed", Article IX, entitled "Scavengers", Section 25.902 of the Municipal Code of St. Charles, Illinois be amended to increase the number of scavenger's licenses to six. Chapter 25, Article IX, Section 25.902 of the St. Charles Municipal Code shall hereafter read as follows:

"25.902 Applications.) Annual application for such license shall be made to the City Clerk, prior to May first of each calendar year, and shall be referred by him to the Mayor and City Council for recommendation; no such license shall be issued except on order of the Mayor and City Council. No more than six (6) scavenger's licenses shall be in force in the City of St. Charles at any one time. Each scavenger must file with the City Clerk of the City of St. Charles a list of its charges for commercial, business and industrial establishments on or before May first, of each calendar year."

This ordinance shall be in effect after its passage, approval and publication pursuant to law.
