ORDINANCE NO. 1977-M-18

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE SALARY OF THE MAYOR

WHEREAS the finance committee has made a study of the salary of the mayor in relationship to municipalities of like size and character and has made its recommendation to the City Council, wherein it was recommended that the salary of the mayor be amended.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ST. CHARLES, ILLINOIS.

Section 1: That the salary of the mayor is hereby fixed as follows: The mayor shall receive a base salary of \$3,000.00 per year for attendance at City Council meetings, committee meetings, other evening meetings and Saturday and Sunday duties. The mayor shall receive additional compensation to be paid at the rate of \$10.00 per hour, for all hours worked during the normal work week—Monday through Friday. The maximum compensation to be paid in accordance with the foregoing shall not exceed \$12,000.00 annually.

Section 2: All ordinances, or parts of ordinances, heretofore adopted in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 3: This Ordinance shall take effect from
and after its passage and approval as required by law.
