ORDONANCE NO. 1977-M-20

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF ST. CHARLES TO PROVIDE FOR APPOINTING MEMBERS TO THE BOARD OF LOCAL IMPROVEMENTS

WHEREAS, Chapter 24 (Illinois Municipal Code) Section 9-2-7 provides in pertinent part:

". . .In cities having a population of less than 50,000. . ., the Board of Local Improvements shall consist of the Mayor the City, . . . and the Public Engineer and the Superintendent of Streets of the municipality, where such officers are provided by Ordinance. But if at any time such officers are not so provided for, the corporate authorities, by Ordinance, shall designate two or more members of their body who, with the Mayor. . .shall constitute the members of the board, until otherwise provided by Ordinance. The Mayor. . .shall be the President of the Board."

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ST. CHARLES, ILLINOIS:

1. Chapter 9 entitled Boards and Commissions is hereby amended to add Article XI which shall read as follows:

"Article XI Board of Local Improvements 10.001 Creation) There is hereby created a Board of Local Improvements of the City of St. Charles. The Mayor shall be President of the Board. Alderman Ron Johnston Alderman Frank Kleber Alderman Jack Albrecht and Alderman, shall be members of the Board. The said Mayor and Aldermen shall constitute the membership of the Board.

10.1002 Duties) It shall be the duty of the Board of Local Improvements to carry out the responsibilities imposed upon them in accordance with law."
