AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 24,
 ENTITLED "DEALERS IN INTOXICATING LIQUORS"
 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF ST. CHARLES

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ST. CHARLES,
 KANE AND DUPAGE COUNTIES, ILLINOIS, as follows:

(1) That Chapter 24, Section 24.029, Subsection 2 of the
 Municipal Code of the City of St. Charles is hereby amended to read as
 follows:


2. Class "B" license shall authorize the retail sale
 of alcoholic liquors on the premises of any tavern
 (1) for consumption on the premises, provided that
 if located in a hotel or motel there shall be no
 retail package sales nor any room service. The
 annual license fee for such licenses shall be
 \$500.00.

(2) This ordinance shall be in effect after its passage,
 approval and publication pursuant to law.
