

ORDINANCE NO. 1978-M-29

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 10, SECTION 10.603 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF ST. CHARLES

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ST. CHARLES, KANE AND DUPAGE COUNTIES, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

1. That Chapter 10, Section 10.603 Prisoners) of the Municipal Code of St. Charles is deleted and the following substituted therefor:

10.603 Prisoners) The jail shall be used for the incarceration of all persons arrested for violating any laws of the State of Illinois, the United States, or for violating any City ordinance, until such person shall be lawfully brought before a judge for a hearing, or until such person shall be lawfully transferred to some other place of incarceration, or otherwise lawfully released.


2. That Chapter 10, Section 10.603 Prisoners) of the Municipal Code of St. Charles, as hereinbefore and hereafter amended shall remain in full force and effect.

3. That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication according to law.
