ORDINANCE NO. 1978-M-34

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 25,  
ARTICLE IX, REFUSE COLLECTORS, OF  
THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF  
ST. CHARLES

---

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF  
ST. CHARLES, KANE AND DUPAGE COUNTIES, ILLINOIS, AS  
FOLLOWS:

1. That Chapter 25, Article IX, Refuse Collectors,  
of the Municipal Code of St. Charles is deleted and the  
following substituted therefor:

ARTICLE IX. REFUSE COLLECTORS

25.901 License Required) It shall be unlawful  
for any person, firm or corporation to engage in  
the business of refuse collector, namely, the  
collection or disposal of animal, human or vegetable  
refuse, or offal, or refuse of any kind, without  
having first secured a license therefor. A license  
may not be assigned, transferred or conveyed in any  
manner without the consent and approval of the Mayor  
and City Council of the City of St. Charles, Illinois.

25.902 Applications) Annual application for such  
license shall be made to the City Clerk, prior to  
May first of each calendar year, and shall be  
referred by him to the Mayor and City Council for  
recommendation; no such license shall be issued  
except on order of the Mayor and City Council. No  
more than six (6) refuse collectors' licenses shall  
be in force in the City of St. Charles at any one  
time. Each collector must file with the City Clerk  
of the City of St. Charles a list of its charges  
for commercial, business and industrial establish-  
ments or or before May first of each calendar year.

25.903 Fee) The annual fee for such license shall be Two Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$250.00).

25.904 Vehicles) Any vehicle used by such refuse collector in his business shall be water-tight and equipped with air-tight covers for such portions as are used for the transportation of garbage or similar refuse. It shall be unlawful for any such vehicle to be driven over or through any street in the City during or on Sunday.

25.905 Disposal) It shall be unlawful for any refuse collector to dispose of or store any refuse in any place within the City limits or within one mile and one-half thereof, except with the permission of the Mayor and City Council.

25.906 Penalty) Any person, firm or corporation violating any provision of this article shall be fined not less than Five Dollars (\$5.00) nor more than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) for each offense, and a separate offense shall be deemed committed on each day during or on which a violation occurs or continues.


2. That Chapter 25, Article IX, Refuse Collectors, of the Municipal Code of St. Charles, as hereinbefore and hereafter amended shall remain in full force and effect.

3. That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication according to law.
