ORDINANCE NO. 1978-M- 4

ORDINANCE PROHIBITING PARKING ON THE
 NORTH SIDE OF HORNE STREET
 BETWEEN SIXTH STREET AND SEVENTH STREET
IN THE CITY OF ST. CHARLES, ILLINOIS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ST.
 CHARLES, KANE COUNTY, ILLINOIS: that

Section 1: It shall be unlawful for the operator or the owner of any vehicle to cause or permit said vehicle to stop, stand or park (except in obedience to a traffic control devise) at any time on the north side of Horne Street from the east right-of-way line of Sixth Street to the west right-of-way line of Seventh Street in the City of St. Charles, Kane County, Illinois.

Section 2: Any person who violates this Ordinance shall be fined not less than \$5.00 nor more than \$500.00 for each offense.

Section 3: Any person accused of a violation of an ordinance restricting the length of time a vehicle may be there parked or prohibiting parking a vehicle in a designated area, may settle and compromise the claim against him or her for such illegal parking by paying to the City the sum of \$5.00. If the fine is not paid within 72 hours after ticketing exclusive of Saturdays, Sundays and holidays, the Police Department shall initiate the appropriate legal action against the alleged violator. Such payment may be made at the police station, in person, or by United States Mail and a receipt shall be prepared for all money so received.

Such money shall be promptly turned over to the general fund.

Section 4: That Chapter 18, Section 18.501, Subparagraph 13 of the Municipal Code of the City of St. Charles, Illinois is hereby amended to reflect the aforementioned restriction on parking.


Section 5: The Director of Public Works is hereby directed to post or to be erected and maintained suitable signs bearing the inscription "No Parking At Any Time".

Section 6: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication.
