BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ST. CHARLES, KANE AND DUPAGE COUNTIES, ILLINOIS, THAT:

Section 1. That Chapter 28 entitled "Misdemeanors and Other Offenses", Section 28.017, but not including Section 28.017(a) be and it is hereby deleted and the following substituted therefor:

"Section 1. Section 28.017 Bathing. It shall be unlawful for any person to swim or bathe at any public place or in a place open to public view unless such person is adequately garbed in a bathing suit or other suitable garment to protect his person from exposure."

Section 2. That said Section 28.017, but not including Section 28.017(a) as hereinabove amended shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 3. Penalty. Any person, firm or corporation violating any provision of this article shall be fined not less than five dollars nor more than five hundred dollars for each offense; and a separate offense shall be deemed committed on each day during or on which a violation occurs or continues.

Section 4. That this Ordinance shall become effective upon its passage, approval and publication as in accordance with law.


