

ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER XV ENTITLED
 "WATER" OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF ST.
CHARLES, ILLINOIS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ST. CHARLES,
 ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

1. That Chapter XV, Section 15.105, entitled "Service Connection Fees", Paragraphs A and B are hereby amended so that they shall hereafter read as follows:

15.105 A. Residential - the connection fee shall be \$450.00 per unit. No connection shall be made by any person or firm other than a licensed plumber or contractor, bonded in the City of St. Charles, and approved by the Director of Public Works. All connections shall be made with a corporation stop, curb stop and curb box of a type approved for use in the City of St. Charles.

If the St. Charles Water Department is responsible for making the connection to the water main, then the following additional fee shall be added to the connection fee for such services:

For a 3/4" tap	\$200.00
For a 1" tap	225.00
For a 1 1/4" tap	340.00
For a 1 1/2" tap	410.00
For a 2" tap	550.00

For taps larger than 2", the charge will be the cost to the city of making such tap plus 15%.

After payment of the above stipulated fees for making the connection to the water main, the St. Charles Water Department shall furnish and install a corporation stop, the service pipe to the curb stop, and the curb stop and curb box. These aforementioned items and services shall be furnished only after suitable trench excavation has been provided by the customer or his (Licensed contractor). The customer shall also be responsible for the proper back-filling of the trench and any necessary patching-sidewalk, curb or paving.

B. Commercial and Industrial - the connection fee shall be \$1.75 per gallon per day of estimated usage subject to a minimum of \$450.00. Commercial and industrial shall include hotels and motels. No connection shall be made by any person or firm other than a licensed plumber or contractor, bonded in the City of St. Charles and approved by the Director of Public Works. All connections shall be made with a corporation stop, curb stop and curb box of a type approved for use in the City of St. Charles.

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Estimated usage shall be determined by the City and user. Once the actual usage begins and it is determined that the actual usage has increased over the estimated usage, there will then be an additional fee for that amount over the original estimated usage based on \$1.75 per gallon per day. There will be no rebates if the actual use falls below the estimated usage.

2. That Chapter XV, Section 15.305, entitled "Rates" is hereby amended so it shall hereafter read as follows:

"All property upon which any building has been or may be hereafter erected having a connection with the water system shall pay the following net charges:

A. \$3.50 per quarter plus the following charge for water used per quarter:

\$0.66 per thousand gallons

B. Sale out of City Limits:

(1) For water supplied to customers who occupy single family residences the charge shall be the rate set forth in Paragraph A above plus an additional \$30.00 annually to be paid quarterly.

(2) Lockes Vending shall pay the rate set forth in Paragraph A above plus an additional \$9.00 annually to be paid quarterly.

(3) St. Charles Bowl shall pay the rate set forth in Paragraph A above plus an additional \$60.00 annually to be paid quarterly.

(4) Mercantile Plaza shall pay the rate set forth in Paragraph A above plus an additional \$12.00 annually to be paid quarterly.

(5) Home Hardware shall pay the rate set forth in Paragraph A above plus an additional \$21.00 annually to be paid quarterly.

(6) DePauw Industries shall pay the rate set forth in Paragraph A above plus an additional \$6.00 annually to be paid quarterly.

(7) Driessen Construction shall pay the rate set forth in Paragraph A above plus an additional \$6.00 annually to be paid quarterly.

(8) Boynton Plastic Service shall pay the rate set forth in Paragraph A above plus an additional \$12.00 annually to be paid quarterly.

(9) Port of Entry shall pay the rate set forth in Paragraph A above plus an additional \$60.00 annually to be paid quarterly.

(10) St. Charles Country Club shall pay the rate set forth in Paragraph A above plus an additional \$540.00 annually to be paid quarterly.

(11) Moline Malleable shall pay the rate set forth in Paragraph A above plus an additional \$2,400.00 annually to be paid quarterly.

C. The gross charge shall be 10 percent more than the net charge."

3. That Chapter XV, Section 15.301, entitled "Meters Required," is hereby amended so it shall hereafter read as follows:

15.301 Meters Required. - All premises using the city water supply must be equipped with an adequate water meter furnished by the city, but paid for by the consumer, as the following rates:

- 5/8" x 3/4".....\$ 120.00
- 3/4".....\$ 150.00

Meters Required (continued)

1".....	\$ 190.00
1½".....	340.00
2" Compound.....	900.00
3" Compound.....	1,250.00
4" Compound.....	1,750.00


Fees for meters not listed over 1½" will be based upon the cost to the City installed plus 15%.

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication pursuant to law.




