WHEREAS, a petition has been filed by William D. Greene, owner of property in the City of St. Charles, Illinois, to amend Ordinance No. 1960-16 known as the Zoning Ordinance of the City of St. Charles, Illinois, as amended; and

WHEREAS, the Plan Commission and Zoning Board of Appeals of the City of St. Charles have held hearings on the petition to amend the Zoning Ordinance in accordance with law; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of St. Charles has received the recommendations of the Plan Commission and Zoning Board of Appeals and has considered same;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ST. CHARLES, ILLINOIS:

That Section VIII, "Business Districts," paragraph C., "B-2 Community Business District," subparagraph 3., "Special Uses," of the St. Charles Zoning Ordinance No. 1960-16, as amended, be hereby further amended to add the following:

- n. Pet shops selling small pets such as birds, fish, mice, hamsters, salamanders, guinea pigs, but not including cats or dogs.


This ordinance shall be effective upon its passage, approval and publication pursuant to law.
