AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 14 OF THE
ST. CHARLES MUNICIPAL CODE OF 1965
ENTITLED "ELECTRICITY"

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ST. CHARLES, KANE AND
DUPAGE COUNTIES, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1. The following paragraphs of Chapter 14 entitled "Electricity"
of the St. Charles Municipal Code be amended so that they shall hereafter read as
follows:

14.104 Rates, Paragraph A Rate 1 - Residential, 2. Energy Charge

2A. Monthly Customer Charge - The net monthly customer charge shall
be \$1.45.

2B. Energy Charge -

<u>NET</u>	<u>KILOWATT HOURS SUPPLIED IN THE MONTH</u>
\$.06638 per kilowatt hour for the first	100
.04826 per kilowatt hour for the next	400
.05591 per kilowatt hour for the next	500
.06341 per kilowatt hour for all over	1,000

2C. Three Phase Service - Where three-phase service is provided there
shall be an additional monthly charge of \$5.00.

2D. Minimum Charge - The minimum monthly charge shall be the net monthly
customer charge.

2E. Gross Charge - The gross charge shall be ten percent more than the
net charge.

14.104 Rates Paragraph B Rate 2 - Residential Space Heating, 2. Energy
Charge.

2A. Monthly Customer Charge - The net monthly customer charge shall be
\$1.45.

2B. Energy Charge -

<u>NET</u>	<u>KILOWATT HOURS SUPPLIED IN THE MONTH</u>
\$.06638 per kilowatt hour for the first	100
.04826 per kilowatt hour for the next	400
.05591 per kilowatt hour for the next	100
.03100 per kilowatt hour for all over	600

except that the net charge shall be \$.05591 per kilowatt hour for
all use over 600 kilowatt hours per month but less than 1,000 kilowatt
hours per month, and \$.06341 per kilowatt hour for use of 1,000 kilowatt
hours per month and above in the first monthly billing period with an
ending meter reading date on or after June 15 and in the three
succeeding monthly billing periods.

2C. Three Phase Service - Where three-phase service is provided there
shall be an additional monthly charge of \$5.00.

2D. Minimum Charge - The minimum monthly charge shall be the net monthly
customer charge.

2E. Gross Charge - The gross energy charge shall be ten percent more than
the net charge.

14.104 Rates, Paragraph D, Rate 4 - Central Commercial District -
Paragraph D is hereby repealed.

14.104 Rates Paragraph E Rate 5 Commercial/Industrial, 2. Charges

2A. Monthly Customer Charge - The net monthly customer charge shall be \$1.86.

2B. Demand Charge -

<u>NET</u>		<u>KILOWATTS OF MAXIMUM DEMAND FOR THE MONTH</u>
<u>SUMMER MONTHS</u>	<u>ALL OTHER MONTHS</u>	
\$6.85	\$5.94	per kilowatt for the first 1,000
6.54	5.67	per kilowatt for all over 1,000

For the purposes hereof the "summer months" shall be the customer's first monthly billing period with an ending meter reading date on or after June 15 and the three succeeding monthly billing periods.

For customers without demand meters, there shall be no demand charge as such, but, in lieu thereof, such customers shall pay \$.02763 per kilowatthour in summer months and \$.02210 per kilowatthour in all other months in addition to the net energy charges set forth below.

2C. Energy Charge -

<u>NET</u>	<u>KILOWATT HOURS SUPPLIED IN THE MONTH</u>
First 100,000 kilowatthours supplied in the month:	
\$.04181	per kilowatthour for the first 6,000
.03682	per kilowatthour for the next 24,000
.02938	per kilowatthour for the next 70,000
Over 100,000 kilowatthours supplied in the month:	
\$.02552	per kilowatthour for the first 400,000
.02282	per kilowatthour for the next 9,500,000
.02146	per kilowatthour for all over 10,000,000

except that the charge for such kilowatthours in excess of the product of 450 times the kilowatts of maximum demand shall be reduced by \$.00487 per kilowatthour.

2D. Three Phase Service - Where three-phase service is provided, there shall be an additional monthly charge of \$5.00.

2E. Minimum Charge - The minimum monthly charge shall be the net monthly customer charge.

2F. Gross Charge - The gross energy charge shall be ten percent more than the net charge.

14.104 Rates, Paragraph G, Rate 6 - Commercial/Industrial Electric Space Heating, 2. Energy Charge and 3. Combined Heating and Cooling Facilities:

2. Energy Charge - Subject to the provisions set forth in the following paragraph entitled "Combined Heating and Cooling Facilities" the charge for electric service supplied for space heating under this rate during the non-summer months shall be the lower of (a) the sum of \$.03100 net per kilowatthour and the fuel adjustment or (b) the charges, under the Customer's rate, for adding such service to the service otherwise supplied to the Customer, except that such charge shall apply only to electricity supplied to facilities used exclusively for space heating or for a combination of space heating and cooling.

For the purpose of determining whether the minimum demand charge has been satisfied in any month in which (a) of the preceding sentence is operative, the net demand charge billing computed under the Customer's rate shall be increased by an amount equal to the excess of (i) the charges computed under (a) over (ii) the additional energy charges, computed under such rate, for the electric space heating service added to the service otherwise supplied to the Customer.

For the purposes hereof and as set forth in the following paragraph entitled "Combined Heating and Cooling Facilities" the "summer months" shall be the Customer's first monthly billing period with an ending meter reading date on or after June 15 and the three succeeding monthly billing periods. "Non-summer" months shall be all other monthly billing periods.

3. Combined Heating and Cooling Facilities - If the customer uses the City's electric service for both space heating and cooling, all of the electricity supplied for such purposes during the "non-summer months" shall be deemed to be supplied for space heating. The meters through which such service is provided shall be read and billed so that service for cooling outside such heating period shall not be charged for hereunder.

14.104 Paragraph F, All Rates - Fuel Adjustment

A fuel adjustment charge or credit shall be applicable to all kilowatt hours supplied in the month. The charge or credit per kilowatt hour will be designated on the bill. The fuel adjustment figure used shall be identical to that paid by the City on its prior month's invoice for electrical energy supplied by Commonwealth Edison Company.


Section 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval in accordance with law.


