BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
ST. CHARLES, KANE AND DU PAGE COUNTIES, ILLINOIS, as follows:

1. That Section 12.04.100 of the St. Charles Municipal
Code entitled "Private Use of Public Places Restricted" be
and is hereby amended by deleting the same and substituting
therefor the following:


"It is unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to use any street, sidewalk or other public place, as space for the display of goods or merchandise for sale; or to write or mark any signs or advertisement on any such pavement. The City Council may designate one or more days a year at its sole discretion when merchandise may be displayed and sold on the sidewalks of the City. However, display and sale of merchandise shall be confined to the sidewalks and City parking areas adjacent business-zoned property and provided, further, that the City may require a liability insurance policy naming the City as an additional insured and an indemnity agreement covering all such businesses displaying and selling merchandise. Such liability policy or policies shall be in an amount and issued by such company or companies as are acceptable to the City Council. The provision of this ordinance providing for the display and sale of merchandise on sidewalks and City parking areas shall not be construed as a lease, and any all sales of merchandise pursuant to the provisions of this ordinance shall be in compliance with all ordinances of the City of St. Charles."

2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in accordance with law.


