BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF

ST. CHARLES, KANE AND DU PAGE COUNTIES, ILLINOIS, as follows:

1. That Chapter 5.08 "Alcoholic Beverages", Section 5.08.080 "License-Classes and Fees", be and is hereby amended by deleting subsection "A" and substituting the following therefor:


"A. Class "A" license shall authorize as a principle business retail sale of alcoholic liquors in packages and not for consumption on the premises. Curb services or sale is prohibited. The annual license fee for such license shall be One Thousand Two Hundred Dollars (\$1,200.00).

2. That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in accordance with law.


