

ORDINANCE NO. 1981-M- 7

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 5.08 ENTITLED,  
 "ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES", SECTION 5.08.080  
 "LICENSE-CLASSES AND FEES" AND  
SECTION 5.08.090 "LICENSE-NUMBER TO BE ISSUED"

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ST.  
 CHARLES, KANE AND DU PAGE COUNTIES, ILLINOIS, as follows:

1. That Chapter 5.08 "Alcoholic Beverages", Section  
 5.08.080 "License-Classes and Fees", be and is hereby amended  
 by adding the following thereto:

" N. Class "N" licenses shall authorize the  
 retail sale of beer and wine to be consumed on the  
 premises at a banquet, picnic, bazaar, fair or  
 similar assembly where food is dispensed and only  
 where the dispensing of food predominates, for a  
 period of twenty-four (24) hours or less subject to  
 the applicable closing hours provisions as set forth  
 in the St. Charles Municipal Code. Such license  
 shall be issued only to not-for-profit organizations. Each  
 shall obtain a permit from the Illinois Liquor Control  
 Commission. No more than one such license shall be  
 issued to any organization within any 365 day period.  
 No more than one Class "N" license shall be issued  
 for any 24 hour period. Evidence of adequate dram  
 shop insurance and liability insurance (if for an  
 out-of-doors license) issued by an insurance carrier

approved by the Liquor Commissioner shall accompany any application for a license. There shall be a minimum of five (5) liquor supervisors for every one hundred (100) persons in attendance during the hours of the license. The liquor supervisors shall be members of the organization to which the license is issued and shall insure maintenance of the public peace. The fee for such license shall be TEN Dollars (\$10.00). The initial license fee of double the fee charged in the class shall not be applicable to a Class "N" license."

2. That Chapter 5.08 "Alcoholic Beverages", Section 5.08.090 "License-Number to be Issued", be and is hereby amended by deleting the same and substituting the following therefor:

"There shall be issued not more than a maximum of five (5) Class "A", ten (10) Class "B", ten (10) Class "C", one (1) Class "D", one (1) Class "E", three (3) Class "F", and permitted supplementary license for Class "D" licenses in any license year, three (3) Class "I" licenses, plus one (1) license for each of the special restricted classes as set forth herein, plus twelve (12) Class "N" licenses."

3. Penalty. Any person, firm, or corporation violating any provision of this Ordinance shall be fined not less than \$25.00 nor more than \$500.00 for each offense and a separate offense shall be deemed committed on each day during or on which a violation occurs or continues.

4. That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in accordance with law, but no sooner than May 1, 1981.


