BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ST. CHARLES, KANE AND DU PAGE COUNTIES, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:



That Title 5, "Business Licenses and Regulations", Chapter 5.14, "Coin-operated Amusement Devices", Section 5.14.100, "Rules of Operation - Designated", of the St. Charles Municipal Code, be and is hereby amended by deleting Subsection A 3 reading, "No person under twelve years of age...." and renumbering Subsection A 4 as Subsection A 3.

2. That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in accordance with law and publication in pamphlet form is hereby authorized.


