

WHEREAS, the City of St. Charles is desirous of electing to participate in the programs under the Illinois Fire Protection Training Act, Public Act 77-1665, as amended; and

WHEREAS, in order for the City to be eligible for initial and continued participation in the programs, the law requires that before an individual may commence regular employment as a firefighter, that individual must have been certified by the State Fire Marshall as having successfully completed an approved Firefighter II training course; and

WHEREAS, the City of St. Charles has established its own school or may utilize some other school or schools certified by the State Fire Marshall for the purpose of providing the training required under said Act;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of St. Charles, Kane and Du Page Counties, Illinois, as follows:

1. That Title 2, Chapter 2.30 entitled, "Fire Department", be and is hereby amended by adding Section 2.30.190 as follows:

"2.30.190 Fire Protection Training

A. The City of St. Charles hereby elects to participate in the training programs provided for in the Illinois Fire Protection Training Act.

B. Before an individual may commence regular full-time employment as a firefighter, said individual must have been certified by the Illinois State Fire Marshall as a Firefighter II, as having successfully completed a course approved by the Office of the State Fire Marshall.

C. Except for the paid-on-call personnel, the Firefighter II training must be completed by the trainee within that individual's probationary period of one (1) calendar year from the initial date of probationary appointment.

D. The Board of Fire and Police Commissioners is hereby authorized to make any necessary amendments to the Personnel Rules, the Manual of Rules and Regulations of the St. Charles Fire Department, and the Rules of said Board of Fire and Police Commissioners in order to require that any person appointed to the Fire Department of St. Charles, Illinois shall not become a regular member of the St. Charles Fire Department unless and until he shall complete, pursuant to said Illinois Fire Protection and Training Act, the approved course within one (1) calendar year of said person's date of probationary appointment."

2. That the Fire Chief be and is hereby authorized and directed to submit a certified copy of this Ordinance to the Office of State Fire Marshall on or before January 1, 1983.


3. That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in




