



ORDINANCE NO. 1983-M- 46

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 12, "STREETS,
SIDEWALKS AND PUBLIC PLACES", CHAPTER 12.04,
"GENERAL PROVISIONS", SECTION 12.04.100,
"PRIVATE USE OF PUBLIC PLACES RESTRICTED",
OF THE ST. CHARLES MUNICIPAL CODE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
ST. CHARLES, KANE AND DU PAGE COUNTIES, ILLINOIS, AS
FOLLOWS:

1. That Title 12, "Streets, Sidewalks and Public
Places", Chapter 12.04, "General Provisions", Section
12.04.100, "Private Use of Public Places Restricted", of
the St. Charles Municipal Code, be and is hereby amended
by deleting said Section 12.04.100, "Private Use of Public
Places Restricted", and substituting the following therefor:

"12.04.100 Private use of public places
restricted.

It is unlawful for any person, firm or
corporation to use any street, sidewalk or
other public place, as space for the display
of goods or merchandise for sale, lease,
trade or for free; or to write or mark any
signs or advertisement on any such pavement.
The city council may designate one or more
days a year at its sole discretion when
merchandise may be displayed and sold on the
sidewalks of the city. However, display of
merchandise for sale, lease, trade or for
free, shall be confined to the sidewalks
and city parking areas adjacent business
zoned property; and, provided further, that
the city may require a liability insurance
policy naming the city as an additional
insured and an indemnity agreement covering
all such businesses displaying and selling
merchandise. Such liability policy or
policies shall be in an amount and issued
by such company or companies as are
acceptable to the city council. The pro-
vision of this section providing for the


display and sale of merchandise on sidewalks and city parking areas shall not be construed as a lease, and any/all sales of merchandise pursuant to the provisions of this section shall be in compliance with all ordinances of the city."

2. That after the adoption and approval hereof the Ordinance shall (i) be printed or published in book or pamphlet form, published by the authority of the Council, or (ii) within thirty (30) days after the adoption and approval hereof, be published in a newspaper published in and with a general circulation within the City of St. Charles.
