

ORDINANCE NO. 1983-M-53

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTERS 2.02, 2.04, 2.06  
AND 2.08 OF THE ST. CHARLES MUNICIPAL CODE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF  
ST. CHARLES, KANE AND DU PAGE COUNTIES, ILLINOIS, AS  
FOLLOWS:

1. That Chapters 2.02 "Mayor", 2.04 "City Council",  
2.06 "City Clerk" and 2.08 "City Treasurer" of the  
St. Charles Municipal Code be and are hereby amended  
as follows:

a. By deleting Section 2.02.010 and  
substituting the following:

"2.02.010 Election - Term of office.  
The mayor shall be elected for a four-year  
term, and shall serve until his successor  
is elected and qualified as is provided  
by statute. The mayor shall be inaugurated  
and his term shall commence after the  
conclusion of old business, if any, at  
the first regular or special meeting of  
the corporate authorities in the month  
of May following the general election in  
which the mayor is elected."

b. By deleting Section 2.04.010 and  
substituting the following:

"2.04.010 Election - Terms of office -  
Powers and duties. The members of the city  
council shall be elected and serve for a  
four-year term. The term of the members

of the City Council shall commence after the conclusion of old business, if any, at the first regular or special meeting of the corporate authorities in the month of May following the general election in which such members are elected. The council shall be the legislative division of the city government and shall perform such duties and have such powers as may be authorized by statute."

c. By deleting Section 2.06.010 and substituting the following:

"2.06.010 Election - Term of office. The city clerk shall be elected as provided by statute, and shall serve until his successor is elected and qualified. The term of the city clerk shall commence after the conclusion of old business, if any, at the first regular or special meeting of the corporate authorities in the month of May following the general election in which he is elected."

d. By deleting Section 2.08.010 and substituting the following:

"2.08.010 Election - Term of office. The city treasurer shall be elected and serve for a four-year term and until his successor is qualified, as is provided by statute. The term of the city treasurer shall commence after the conclusion of old business, if any, at the first regular or special meeting of the corporate authorities in the month of May following the general election in which he is elected."


2. That after the adoption and approval hereof the Ordinance shall (i) be printed or published in book

or pamphlet form, published by the authority of the Council, or (ii) within thirty (30) days after the adoption and approval hereof, be published in a newspaper published in and with a general circulation within the City of St. Charles.


